

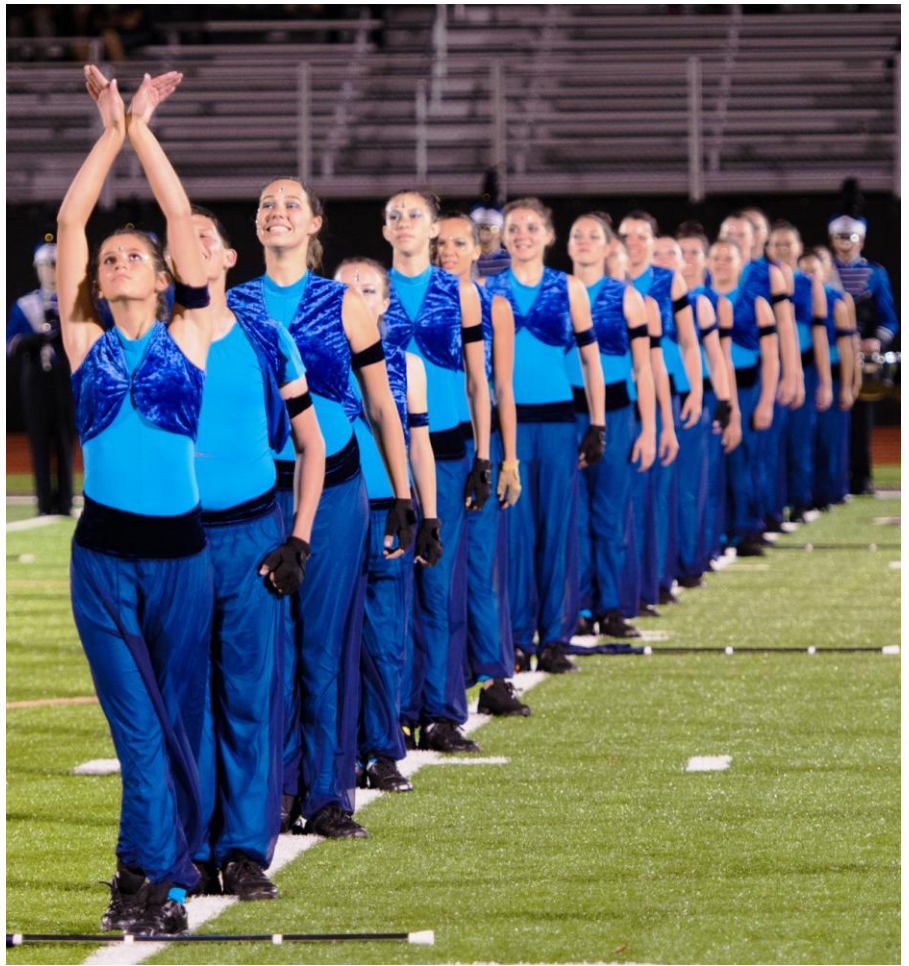
Supporting a long tradition

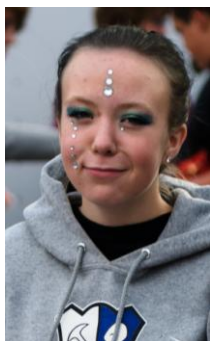
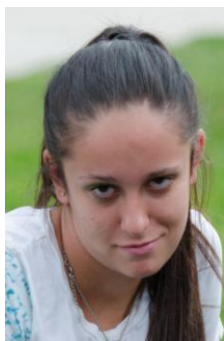
In mid October, the 39th annual Davis Cup Invitational invited some of the top bands in Utah and Eastern Idaho for the state's oldest marching band competition.
