
## **BINGHAM BASKETBALL**

## Syracuse 63, Bingham 41

**Story of the game:** Brittney Martin scored 11 of her game-high 29 points in the third period as Syracuse blew out Bingham in a battle of 5A girls basketball powers.

**Bingham's highlights:** Brooke Blonquist led Bingham with 10 points and Lateesha Richards added nine. The Miners were within 30-25 at halftime, thanks mostly to Blonqust. Bingham was called for just one foul in the first half. This was not an ordinary game.

**Syracuse's highlights:** Martin put on a great show. She had 10 points in the first quarter and then dominated the third period. Hailey Judd had 11 points and Hailee Parry 10. This was Syracuse's first real test of the season and the Titans passed.

**Statistical notes:** Bingham's 41-point effort was its season low. This was also the Miners' worst defeat of the year. Summer Yack had all seven of her points in the second half, whereas Brooke Blonquist had all of her points in the first half.

What we learned from this game: This was a matchup between two offensive powers, but it was Syracuse's defense that made the difference. Syracuse stayed undefeated with the win and made a statement with this conquest.
