

Jan. 18 – Bingham 65, Herriman 22

Story of the game: Lateesha Richards had 10 points, including six during the first quarter when Bingham grabbed a big lead, as the Miners had no trouble with Herriman in a Region 3 game.

Bingham’s highlights: The Miners put this game away early. They built a 26-4 lead in the first quarter and then coasted from there. Bingham played its entire roster. Chantee Renouard and Brooke Blonquist had eight points each and Summer Yack had seven.

Herriman’s highlights: The Mustangs were hassled on the perimeter and had far too many turnovers. Torie Bradshaw and Keshley Roundy had eight points apiece.

Statistical notes: This was Bingham’s most lopsided region victory of the season, and the Miners continued to build the margin throughout the game. Herriman made just 1-6 free throws.

What we learned from this game: This was the first-ever meeting in girls basketball between these two schools. This kind of rout was pretty much expected. Herriman doesn’t have the guards to handle Bingham’s constant pressure. Despite the score, the Miners didn’t feel like they poured it on. All 17 available players got into the game and 14 scored.

Jan. 20 – Bingham 67, West Jordan 34

Story of the game: Summer Yack scored 15 points and led another balanced scoring attack as Bingham dominated early and went on to handily defeat West Jordan in a Region 3 game.

Bingham’s highlights: Yack started the game with a pair of three-pointers, but she got a lot of help as the Miners took a 38-12 advantage into halftime. Bingham made five three-pointers and they all came in the first half. Jillian Powell had nine points and Brooke Blonquist and Lateesha Richards each had eight.

West Jordan’s highlights: The Jaguars didn’t get much from their starters, who totaled just 12 points. Annie Oliver and Nicole Counsel had seven points.

Statistical notes: The Miners held an opponent to four points in the first quarter for the second straight game. Yack was 5-5 from the free-throw line and Bingham was 16-22 overall. More than half of Bingham’s points in the second half came from the charity line.

What we learned from this game: Not much. In Region 3, there’s the top three teams (Bingham, Riverton, Taylorsville), a middle team (Kearns) and the bottom dwellers (West Jordan, Copper Hills and Herriman). This season, there would be no big upsets.
