

Jan. 25 – Bingham 65, Copper Hills 38

Story of the game: Summer Yack scored 12 of her game-high 15 points in the first half and played a big role as Bingham had its highest-scoring half of the season en route to a convincing Region 3 win over Copper Hills.

Bingham’s highlights: The Miners held a 19-10 lead and then outscored the Grizzlies 29-4 in the second period to build a huge margin. Leticia Lewis added 10 points as Bingham continued to dominate and built the lead to almost 40 points at one time.

Copper Hills’ highlights: Savannah Moir had six points in the first quarter and kept Copper Hills in the contest early. She finished with eight points, tying teammates Kaitlyn Burtenshaw and Desirae Cruse for scoring honors.

Statistical notes: In the second quarter, Bingham got 12 of its 14 points from the free-throw line, and hit 12-14 from the charity line during that time. The 29-point quarter was a season best. The Miners also made 50 percent of their field goals. Even though the fourth quarter didn’t mean much, it was Bingham’s worst of the season.

What we learned from this game: The Miners remained tied for first place with the victory, and coach Rasmussen was able to give playing time to a lot of different players.

Story of the game: Leticia Lewis, Katie Lloyd and Summer Yack each scored in double figures as Bingham built a big first-quarter lead and rolled to another easy Region 3 victory.

Bingham’s highlights: Lewis got Bingham rolling early with a pair of three-point baskets. She scored all 12 of her points in the first half. The Miners had a huge 53-12 lead by halftime and substituted freely. Bingham shot 55 percent from the field, a season best.

Kearns’ highlights: Micaelee Orton was back from injury and scored 15 points. Rachel Graham, who had 22 the last time these teams played, had just two on this night. This was the Cougars’ worst loss of the season.

Statistical notes: Lloyd’s 11 points was her season high, as was Bingham’s 53 first-half points. Bingham shot just five free throws during the game.

What we learned from this game: Shelby Richards returned after missing eight games and scored two points. The Miners had 18 different players in the game and 15 scored. This was another “easy” game, and now the tough part of their schedule begins.
