

Feb. 10 – Bingham 60, Herriman 37

Story of the game: Brooke Blonquist scored 11 points and Summer Yack had 10 as Bingham rolled past Herriman in a Region 3 matchup.

Bingham’s highlights: Once again, the Miners jumped on Herriman early. Blonquist had seven points and Yack six in the first period as the Miners built a 22-8 lead. The margin eventually grew to over 30 points before Herriman rallied. Leticia Lewis and Lateesha Richards didn’t play, but the 16 other girls on the roster did. Cheril Lyman and Ashton Henderson added eight points apiece.

Herriman’s highlights: The Mustangs noted that Bingham focused its defense on Lexi Roberts, so Torie Bradshaw came alive with 11 points and coach Jill Ames played as many girls as possible. The Mustangs, however, lost their 11th straight game.

Statistical notes: Bingham shot 47 percent from the field. Bradshaw was the game’s top rebounder with 10. Lyman’s eight points was her career high. For only the third time this season, Yack didn’t make a three-pointer. Lewis is out for a couple of games due to a concussion suffered against Riverton.

What we learned from this game: The outcome of this game was never in doubt. The question was how Bingham would recover from the Riverton loss two nights before.

Feb. 15 – Bingham 70, West Jordan 46

Story of the game: Even though it was “Senior Night,” it was the underclassmen who had big games as Ashton Henderson had 11 points and Summer Yack 10 in Bingham’s Region 3 win over West Jordan.

Bingham’s highlights: Yack had six points in the first period, but the real story was Bingham’s defense, which helped spur a 19-5 lead after eight minutes. The Miners had their busiest night of the season from the free-throw line as West Jordan was whistled for 25 fouls. Lateesha Richards returned but didn’t score.

West Jordan’s highlights: Atkinson ended the regular with another good game, scoring 16 points. Annie Oliver added 11 – all in the second half. The Jaguars scored 31 of their 46 points after halftime.

Statistical notes: With the win, Bingham finished 8-4 at home. The Miners would eventually be 9-0 on the road and 1-1 at neutral sites (SLCC). Bingham’s four seniors combined for just eight points, with Katie Lloyd leading the way with five. Bingham shot a season-high 38 free throws in this game. There were 42 fouls called, but nobody fouled out.

What we learned from this game: Bingham ended its regular season successfully and went into state with some momentum. The Miners finished in second place in region.
