Story of the game: Cole Christensen scored four goals and Chris Severson and Mike Jones had three apiece as the Miners routed Riverton in their final Sandy Division match of the season.

Bingham's highlights: The Miners put up a lot of offense. The 16 goals scored was their team high for the season. Jones' three goals was also his best effort. Bingham kept Riverton's goalie busy by firing 40 shots. Taylor Morris and Justin Park had two scores each, and Peter Tschaggeny and Jordan Shumway had one each.

Statistical notes: Bingham started fast, and the outcome was never in doubt. Aaron Hansen had nine saves. Jordan, Severson and Shumway were credited with two assists each as Bingham had 10 total on its 16 scores.
