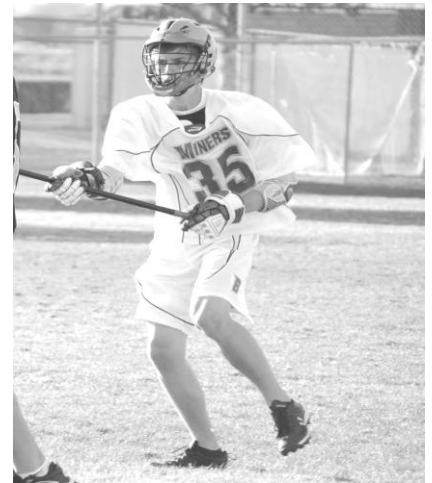
April 21 – Bingham 21, West Jordan 0
