

## Dec. 11 – Mountain View 66, Capital 55

**Story of the game:** Tanner Percifield scored a career-high 34 points, including a flurry of baskets during the third quarter, as Mountain View pulled away from Capital in a 5A SIC game.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The Mavericks switched defenses to combat a hot start by Capital’s Hunter Young and it paid off. The game was tied until Percifield had the best performance of his life. He made nine straight shots at one point.

**Capital’s highlights:** Young got the Eagles off to a good start with a series of three-pointers, and they also made a nice fourth-quarter rally that might have worked if MV hadn’t made its free throws. Cameron Carlsen added 11 points and was part of a balanced-scoring effort.

**Statistical notes:** MV shot 50 percent from the field, was made 7-15 three-pointers. Kody Olson scored seven points and led the team with five rebounds. Ryan Ball had a nice game off the bench.

**What we learned from this game:** A big effort was needed and Percifield had the hot hand. In the third quarter, he took over the game. It was apparent MV wanted him to shoot and he put up one-half of the team’s attempts.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“Down four (points), we switched to a diamond-and-one zone vs. Young to keep the ball out of his hands and it worked. Percifield had a great game from the field. As a team we finally shot free throws well. That was nice to see. I thought Ryan Ball coming off the bench gave us a lift and (Branson) Trube had five assists.”*

## Dec. 13 – Mountain View 58, Boise 50

**Story of the game:** Marcus Slocum, Tanner Percifield and Randall Robinson each scored in double figures as Mountain View built a nice lead and held off Boise for another 5A SIC win.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** Trailing 15-12 after the first quarter, the Mavericks went on a scoring spurt and that was the difference in the game. Slocum had 18 points and it ended up being one of his best games of the season. Jason Maughan had a nice game off the bench and MV shot well (again) from the field.

**Boise’s highlights:** The Braves put a few scares into the home team. The second half was full of offense. Sam Simpson had a great game with 25 points and Brandon Smith had eight off the bench. Boise did a nice job on the boards.

**Statistical notes:** Boise outrebounded MV 30-22 and had several on the offensive end. Simpson’s 25 was his season high. MV helped itself with just nine turnovers and made most of its free throws in the fourth quarter.

**What we learned from this game:** MV returned home and improved to 5-1 on the season, which was good for its morale.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“The game was basically a series of spurts. We went off on a 16-2 run in the second quarter. Everyone got involved, including Maughan and Slocum. Slocum had his best game of the year, while Trube tallied eight assists. Randall shot the ball again pretty well from the field, but the team defense against Boise got the win. We couldn’t stop Simpson but took care of everyone else.”*
