

## Jan. 3 – Mountain View 68, Vallivue 45

**Story of the game:** Tanner Percifield scored 17 points as Mountain View returned from the holidays with a convincing home victory over Vallivue.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The Mavs led most of the way. The offense didn’t miss a beat and it resulted in a season-high point total, despite a slow fourth quarter. Marcus Slocum and Randall Robinson backed up Percifield and Ryan Ball had another nice game off the bench.

**Vallivue’s highlights:** The Falcons rallied in the fourth quarter to make the score more reasonable. Brandon Navarro was the top scorer with nine points and Taylor Duby contributed four points and six rebounds.

**Statistical notes:** MV again had nice passing and shot well almost 60 percent inside the perimeter. Free throw-shooting was a bit off, though. Coach Nettleton was able to empty the bench after Mavs dominated the middle two quarters.

**What we learned from this game:** The Mavs played a great overall game and put this one away with plenty of time to spare. The win was their seventh straight and kept them near the top of the SIC standings.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“Total team effort tonight as everyone played at least seven minutes or so. All but two scored too. We played pretty well from the start, but my biggest appreciation is starting off on offense so well. Last couple of games we have scored 15+ in the first quarter.”*

## Jan. 5 – Rocky Mountain 45, Mountain View 41

**Story of the game:** Tanner Percifield scored 19 points, but Rocky Mountain put the clamps on most everyone else and the Grizzlies ended Mountain View’s win streak with a narrow win.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** After a series of good starts, the Mavericks couldn’t buy a basket early and played from behind. Percifield and Marcus Slocum (10 rebounds) had decent games, and Branson Trube did a nice job defensively.

**Rocky’s highlights:** The Grizzlies got back into the SIC race with this win. Matt Grooms was a factor underneath with 16 points and nine rebounds. John Sherle added 10 points and Logan Skurdal connected on three treys.

**Statistical notes:** Rocky would be MV’s nemesis this year, but the difference between the teams wasn’t much. Trube had an off-night offensively. Only seven MV players got into the game. This had a playoff-type atmosphere in Rocky’s gym.

**What we learned from this game:** Rocky came out out of the locker room with fire in its eyes and held on for a close win. The Mavs got some occasional big plays, but suffered a rare poor-shooting night.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“The first quarter didn't start off well as we couldn't make a shot. We went 2-10 from the field and 0-2 from the free-throw line and found ourselves in a hole. Trube held their leading scorer (E.J. Boyce) to three points but he couldn't tally anything himself. Not having Trube or Randall (Robinson) score hurt us. Tanner kept us in the game and Marcus played huge inside against a much bigger group of post players.”*
