Jan. 11 – Mountain View 53, Timberline 41

Story of the game: Marcus Slocum and Branson Trube scored 14 points apiece and Kody Olson scored a few key baskets to lift Mountain View past Timberline in a 5A SIC game.

Mountain View's highlights: The Mavericks got off to a good start in an arena where it has been traditionally difficult to play. MV led 23-13 at halftime and Olson's baskets in the third quarter helped extend the margin to 44-29. Slocum had nine rebounds going against bigger players.

Timberline's highlights: The Timberwolves had a good 1-2 scoring punch of Grant Saetrum and Jack Tate. Both, however, didn't shoot particularly well, especially from three-point range. Timberline finally got its offense going after halftime.

Statistical notes: Tate and Saetrum combined to shoot just 11-35. MV shot 46 percent as a team, but made just 1-5 free throws. Slocum led both teams in rebounding with nine.

What we learned from this game: The Mavs were coming off consecutive losses and got back on the winning track. You know coach Nettleton talked about how tough it was to play here, and they came out motivated.

Coach Nettleton's comments: *"In the first half, we played great team defense against a much bigger lineup. They started 6-foot-6 and 6-9 and played zone (defense) the first 2 quarters. We were selective and moved the ball around. We got great shots and defended very well. Kody Olson finally got aggressive and started shooting. he had seven pts for us and most of them were from the perimeter. That was big for us as he needs to draw the big defenders out of the lane for my guards to have a lane to attack."*
