

Feb. 1 – Mountain View 61, Eagle 47

Story of the game: Tanner Percifield scored 19 points and Marcus Slocum added 11 as Mountain View played one of its best games all season and whipped Eagle in a 5A SIC game.

Mountain View’s highlights: The Mavs dominated Eagle for the second time. They roared past Eagle in the opening period and had a 27-point lead at one point. Percifield nailed his first three shots – and two were three-pointers. Coach Nettleton was able to play virtually everyone.

Eagle’s highlights: The Mustangs trailed 37-14 at halftime and it got worse before getting better. Braiden Shaw and Jake Stevens each had 10 points apiece, but the Mustangs were never able to consistently make three-pointers. Shaw had a good game underneath with 13 rebounds.

Statistical notes: MV handled Eagle better than any other SIC team all season. The Mavs shot 53.3 percent from the field. The game was played mostly on the perimeter. MV had just six personal fouls. Ethan Secrist scored eight points off the bench.

What we learned from this game: MV needed a big win, and got it. The victory put a lot of space between the third and fourth-place teams in the league.

Coach Nettleton’s comments: *“We started off really well. That seemed to be theme against them. Tanner came out on fire. They outrebounded us, but we played everyone good minutes in the second half and a lot of players earned valuable minutes of experience.”*

Feb. 5 – Mountain View 56, Vallivue 29

Story of the game: Randall Robinson led a balanced-scoring attack with 14 points to help Mountain View rout Vallivue to win its seventh straight game for the second time this season.

Mountain View’s highlights: The defense ruled for much of the game. MV led 28-8 at halftime and extended the margin to 48-12. Ryan Ball, Tanner Page and Ethan Secrist had big games off the bench. Marcus Slocum had seven rebounds as the Mavs dominated the boards.

Vallivue’s highlights: The Falcons put together a nice rally in the fourth quarter to make the score more appealing. Bryce Schroeder was the top scorer with 10 points. Lane Sale didn’t score, but had six rebounds.

Statistical notes: This was MV’s best defensive effort since the opener and marked the second time the Mavs had held a team to just two points in a quarter. Vallivue made just 3-11 free throws on its home floor.

What we learned from this game: With the win, the Mavs were tied for second place with Rocky in the 5A SIC standings. Next week’s season finale will be a big finish.

Coach Nettleton’s comments: *“We jumped out to a 12-2 lead and never looked back. Our defense was key to our great start as we held them to only 12 points for the first 3 quarters.”*
