

## Feb. 12 – Eagle 48, Mountain View 47 (OT)

**Story of the game:** Braiden Shaw scored 10 points and Jake Stevens nine as Eagle shocked Mountain View in overtime in the first round of the 5A District 3 tournament.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The Mavs dominated Eagle during the season, but came out cold on this night. They shot less than 40 percent and Tanner Percifield had one of his toughest nights of the year. Kody Olson led MV with 16 points and his fourth-quarter play helped send the game to OT. Percifield and Randall Robinson added nine each.

**Eagle’s highlights:** This win was probably the biggest in the Mustangs’ season and helped avenge two bad losses earlier in the year. Shaw missed a key FT in OT but came back with a blocked shot that set up Eagle’s game-winning basket.

**Statistical notes:** The Mustangs made 5-15 three-pointers, while MV was 2-12. Shaw led both teams with 12 rebounds and five blocks. Olson had seven boards for MV. Eagle had a nine-point lead going into the final quarter.

**What we learned from this game:** Nobody expected this to happen, and it became a key point in MV’s season. For the next week, they knew they had to win or go home.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“We came out very slow and didn’t shoot well.”*

## Feb. 16 – Mountain View 66, Timberline 55

**Story of the game:** Tanner Percifield scored 27 points as Mountain View broke open a close game in the second half and kept its season alive with a win over Timberline in the 5A District 3 tournament.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The Mavs increased their defensive intensity in the third quarter and rallied from a five-points deficit. Three-point shooting accuracy was down (again), but MV’s passing led to a lot of good shots (54.4 percent). Kody Olson had another fine outing with 14 points.

**Timberline’s highlights:** Grant Saetrum had a good outing with 17 points and he and Jack Tate helped the Timberwolves to a small lead for most of the first half. Gibson Berryhill was also a threat from long range.

**Statistical notes:** MV finished 3-0 against Timberline this season and this win ended the Twolves’ season. MV had 14 assists on 25 baskets. Slocum finished with 11 points and a team-high six rebounds. Timberline lost two players to fouls.

**What we learned from this game:** Both teams suffered tough first-round losses but, by outscoring Timberline 40-24 in the second half, MV kept its season going.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“We came out pretty good ... knowing it was a win or go home kind of game. Our defense in the third was the difference and we shot well the whole game (except from three-point land). We were unselfish and moved the ball around.”*
