

## Nov. 27 – Mountain View 62, Caldwell 24

**Story of the game:** Branson Trube scored 14 points and Tanner Percifield added 10 as Mountain View blew out Caldwell with a big second quarter and handily won its season opener.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The Mavericks dominated the first half and had a 38-12 advantage by intermission. Trube and Jason Maughan each got hot from the perimeter and Kody Olson helped Mountain View take control underneath. The team shot over 53 percent from the field.

**Caldwell’s highlights:** The Cougars had trouble scoring and controlling the ball. Dustin Walker had six points and four rebounds. Only nine players got into the game, even though it was decided early.

**Statistical notes:** The Mavs made 6-8 three-pointers and won the rebounding battle, 38-19. Ryan Ball had eight points off the bench and Carlton Egner added seven. The 24 points allowed would be a season best.

**What we learned from this game:** This was the first game of the season for both teams and Mountain View was clearly the better team. It didn’t take long for that to be determined.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“We had another great start. That was something we talked about since last year. The defense came alive the second quarter.”*

## Nov. 30 – Mountain View 59, Mountain Home 38

**Story of the game:** Tanner Percifield scored 18 points and Jason Maughan chipped in 11 as Mountain View went on the road and whipped Mountain Home in another non-league game.

**Mountain View’s highlights:** The game was close early, but the Mavericks built an 11-point margin by halftime and then blew the game open late. Maughan became a big threat from the perimeter and Marcus Slocum’s efforts (nine rebounds) helped the Mavs get a lot of second shots.

**Mountain Home’s highlights:** Jeremy Hopper (10 points) and Mike Daniels (9) provided most of the offense. MH’s best efforts came in the third quarter when it got the home crowd involved with a small rally.

**Statistical notes:** Ethan Secrist sprained his ankle and his future was uncertain. MV shot 46 percent, but made almost 60 percent of its shots inside the three-point line. Percifield was more a threat to shoot in this game (15 attempts).

**What we learned from this game:** Mountain Home tried to put up a fight. This game was more physical than against Caldwell and it forced the Mavs to play a different style, but they still had no trouble.

**Coach Nettleton’s comments:** *“We talked about shooting free throws better this game and we did, but our three-point shooting was off. I was most happy with our defense in the fourth quarter. Our players need to get used to playing more physical since we open conference play vs. (top-ranked) Borah next. It was a great test and they survived the challenge.”*
