

Dec. 2 – Olympus 66, Davis 54

Story of the game: Colton Stewart scored 21 points and Jordan Marsh added 12 off the bench as Olympus rallied to beat Davis for a rare win on the Darts' home floor.

Oly's highlights: The Titans got off to a slow start, and trailed 19-10 after the first quarter. They cut the margin by halftime and then got their offense really rolling after that. The Titans shot well, and also made their free throws at the end.

Davis' highlights: Oly had a tough time containing Riley Watts early and the Davis star got off to a good start. Trever Webb added 12 points. The Darts' defense, however, struggled and they were beaten badly on the boards.

Statistical notes: Oly outrebounded Davis 28-15, and Stewart had a game-high 12. Oly outscored Davis 43-28 in the second half. The Titans made 16-18 free throws and improved to 2-0.

What we learned from this game: The Titans went on the road for the first time and were not expected to pull out this win. Davis made the 5A title game last year, which made this a big confidence-builder.

Dec. 3 – Olympus 76, Murray 53

Story of the game: Colton Stewart scored 23 points and Sam Williams had 21 as Cottonwood dominated the middle two quarters and went on to rout Murray in a non-region game.

Oly's highlights: The Titans took control in the second quarter. Stewart scored 12 points in that span as Oly built a 10-point lead. Williams and Tanner Curtis got hot from outside after that and Murray was no match.

Murray's highlights: David Collette started the season with a 26-point effort, but the Spartans' didn't have much luck from the perimeter. Riley Grandinetti added 10 points, but Murray made just 4-18 shots from three-point range.

Statistical notes: Oly got into rhythm with its three-point shooting. The Titans had a pair of 24-point quarters that hurt Murray's confidence. Collette had a good game, but Murray's perimeter players combined to make just 4-31 shots. Stewart took Collette outside a number of times and made three treys.

What we learned from this game: This was a surprising win because a lot was expected of Murray, which ended up winning its region and reaching the 5A semifinals. Oly had a big advantage, having played three games while this was Murray's opener. In previous years, this was a big rivalry game and Oly also benefited with a good student turnout.
