

Dec. 17 – Olympus 75, Skyline 62

Story of the game: Colton Stewart scored a career-high 34 points and he and Sam Williams got the Titans rolling in the fourth quarter as they downed neighborhood rival Skyline in a non-region game.

Oly's highlights: This game was tied going into the final period. Williams and Tanner Curtis got hot from outside and Stewart scored from everywhere. The home crowd really got into it as Oly pulled away. Stewart also had 17 rebounds and Oly dominated the boards.

Skyline's highlights: The Eagles got 27 points from Jaden Jackson and he, Patrick Nielsen and Michael Staes helped keep Skyline in the game. Rebounding killed the Eagles and the game got out of hand late.

Statistical notes: Stewart made sure Oly beat its rival for the second straight year. Williams made 3-4 three-point baskets. Tanner Curtis was credited with eight assists and Carter Young had seven.

What we learned from this game: The Titans ended their two-game losing streak and improved to 3-0 at home. This was the only home game in a month-long stretch and it ended up being a memorable one.

Dec. 22 – Olympus 69, Box Elder 67 (OT)

Story of the game: Sam Williams hit two big shots, including the game-winner with three seconds left, to lift Olympus to a non-region overtime win over Box Elder.

Oly's highlights: The Titans lost Colton Stewart to a knee injury early in the game and trailed by as many as 15 points. However, Tanner Curtis made up for Stewart's absence by scoring 24 points and Williams had 23. Several Oly players called this their most-memorable win.

Box Elder's highlights: Brant Mecham suffered one of his worst-ever games at Olympus the year before, but he came out and had a season-high 31 here. Shad Watson had 18. Chad Talbot hit two free throws, which forced overtime. Talbot missed a three at the final buzzer.

Statistical notes: There were 21 three-point baskets in this game, including seven by Mecham. Both teams, however, shot poorly from the free-throw line. This was the first of two OT games this season.

What we learned from this game: Coach Matt Barnes was thrilled that his team didn't give up and had different players step up their game. This was Oly's longest road trip and it provided a thrill to the players. With the exception of perhaps Stewart, the bus ride home had to be a lot of fun for the players.
