

Jan. 14 – Olympus 55, Stansbury 24

Story of the game: Sam Williams scored 16 points as – once again – Olympus opened the second half with a dominating performance and the Titans went on to whip Stansbury in a Region 6 game.

Oly's highlights: The Titans got off to a good start and led 25-19 at halftime. They employed a full-court defense to start the second half and the home crowd was quickly quieted. The Titans went on a 23-1 and the outcome was decided.

Stansbury's highlights: The Stallions played Oly tough in the first half. They never shot well, but Brandon Mohler and Ty Barton at least made it interesting. The 24-point effort was a record low since the school opened two years ago.

Statistical notes: Oly outscored Stansbury 30-5 in the second half. Coach Matt Barnes emptied his bench, and even played his JV players for the first time, although none scored. Tanner Curtis continued his hot shooting from outside.

What we learned from this game: Oly didn't expect to be threatened, but was until the second half. The 24 points allowed was the lowest the Titans have allowed in at least 10 years, allow they gave up just 26 to Skyline last year.

Jan. 21 – Olympus 73, Tooele 44

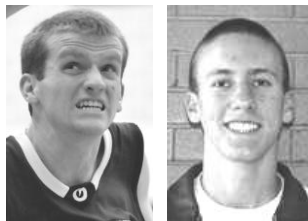
Story of the game: Jordan Marsh scored 14 points and Sam Williams had 13 points and a career-high 10 assists as Oly took control of the game early and whipped Tooele in a Region 6 game.

Oly's highlights: The Titans burned the nets starting midway through the first quarter and went on an 18-0 run, their longest of the season. Oly made 14-24 shots from three-point range and that helped four players reach double figures.

Tooele's highlights: The Buffaloes could have given up, but didn't. Levi Vernon (12 points) and Jack Memmott (nine) made Tooele competitive for two of the game's four quarters.

Statistical notes: The score went back-and-forth early, but Oly's lead eventually reached 35. Tanner Curtis had seven assists as Oly finished with 24 for the game.

What we learned from this game: The Titans once again dominated Tooele and, unlike some of Oly's previous games, this rout started from the beginning. Oly's pressure defense was the difference and that also prevented the crowd from becoming a factor.
