

Feb. 8 – Olympus 71, Stansbury 35

Story of the game: Will Cannon led a balanced scoring effort with 13 points as Olympus dominated the first half defensively and went on to blitz Stansbury in a Region 6 game.

Oly's highlights: The Titans' starters got off to a hot start. A quick 12-0 run helped build 28-5 first-quarter lead and Oly eventually built the margin to an amazing 46 points. Coach Matt Barnes emptied the bench and even let the JVs play.

Stansbury's highlights: The Stallions also emptied their bench. They had a 9-0 run in the fourth quarter that trimmed the margin to something more agreeable. Ty Barton led with 11 points, but Stansbury was unable to make a three-pointer.

Statistical notes: Oly shot almost 60 percent from the field and made 10-23 three-pointers. Eleven different players scored, including some for the first time. Oly shot just four free throws, which tied a season low.

What we learned from this game: Not much. The Titans were preparing for a late-season run at the region title and didn't show any signs of a letdown here. Perhaps someone remembered last year, when the Titans were in a similar situation and beat Stansbury just 58-51 on Oly's home court.

Feb. 11 – Olympus 94, Tooele 52

Story of the game: Sam Williams scored 17 points and led a huge second-quarter effort that led to an easy Region 6 victory for Olympus over Tooele.

Oly's highlights: The Titans trailed early, but rallied late in the first quarter and then buried the Buffaloes with 33 points over the next eight minutes. The Titans made 17 three-pointers during the game and shot over 60 percent overall. Everybody on the bench got to play.

Tooele's highlights: The Buffaloes made this a game early. Levi Vernon finished with 14 points, but Tooele's downfall was 19 turnovers, and the fact it only forced four. This was Tooele's biggest loss of the season.

Statistical notes: The 94 points was obviously a season high and could be a record setter. Five players scored in double figures, but Jackson Coleman and Nic Johnson also added six points apiece. Tooele tried to keep pace by making nine three-pointers.

What we learned from this game: The win was no surprise, but the huge offensive output might have been. With just a few games left, Oly is playing its best basketball and is helping make the Region 6 race very interesting.
