

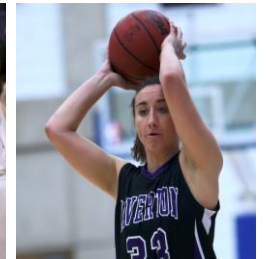
Pume Currie

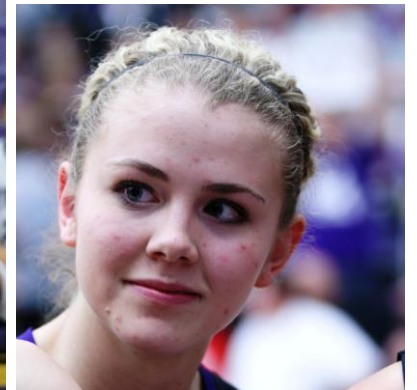
