

Dec. 5 – Bonneville 53, Weber 30

Story of the game: Erin Reichle, Kandice Jensen and Maren Ulrich led Weber in scoring, but the Warriors offense suffered a tough night against 4A power Bonneville and dropped their first game of the season.

Weber’s highlights: The Warriors trailed just 13-9 after the first quarter, but then things got out of hand. Weber managed just two points over the next two quarters and the scoring drought was much too difficult to overcome. Reichle had 10 points and Hanna Buswell was Weber’s lone rebounding threat with 11.

Bonneville’s highlights: The Lakers’ defense had one of their best nights, but their three-point shooting success (6-9) fueled the offense and gathered momentum. Emilie Volk led with 19 points and was a perfect 3-3 from long range. Cortney Porter had 16 points and seven rebounds.

Statistical notes: The Warriors’ 30-point effort was their season low. Reichle was just 2-11, but the team shot just 27.3 percent from the field and just over 50 percent from the free-throw line. They didn’t score in the third quarter, but rallied well after that. Afterward, Buswell was selected Weber’s player of the game.

What we learned from this game: Weber dropped its first game of the season, but Bonneville would wind up being a good team again. The Lakers finished the regular season undefeated and beat all six Region 1 teams on their schedule.

Dec. 7 – Weber 49, Taylorsville 37

Story of the game: Erin Reichle scored 23 points and Kandice Jensen had her best game of the season with 17 to get Weber back on the winning track with a non-region road win over Taylorsville.

Weber’s highlights: Reichle and Jensen were a two-person scoring machine, combining for 40 of Weber’s points. Both players were scoring threats from outside, connecting on 50 percent (8-16) of their three-point shots. Weber led 30-23 at halftime and then held off Taylorsville’s rally attempts, despite poor free-throw shooting.

Taylorsville’s highlights: Abi Black scored nine points, but also added nine steals and the turnover difference kept the game close. Mattie Evensen was another player who had a night to remember, pulling down 18 rebounds.

Statistical notes: This was Weber’s third game in the last four nights. Outside of Reichle and Jensen, Weber’s other players combined to shoot just 4-25. Hanna Buswell helped the effort with 10 rebounds. The teams combined to make just 6-19 free throws. Afterward, Reichle was named Weber’s player of the game.

What we learned from this game: This was Weber’s first road contest. Last year, this was expected to be a better game but Taylorsville fell off this season. It was a big momentum boost, too.
