

Jan. 18 – Syracuse 64, Weber 53

Story of the game: Too many turnovers made the difference for the Weber Warriors as Syracuse finally pulled away in the fourth quarter to claim the Region 1 win.

Weber’s highlights: The game was close for much of the game. Erin Reichle had 22 points, Hannah Charlton 10 and Maren Ulrich and Alyssa Potter added eight each. Weber, however, committed 18 turnovers and had trouble from three-point range (1-13).

Syracuse’s highlights: The Titans took control in the final period, out-scoring Weber 17-8. Takenna Hamblin was unstoppable inside. She made 9-10 shots and led with 24 points. Jayda Bovero had 15, including three treys. Paige Trimble was a surprise, adding eight points and three rebounds.

Statistical notes: The win moved Syracuse to 2-2 in region, while Weber dropped to 1-3. Reichle’s outside shots didn’t drop, but she was 9-9 from the free-throw line. Potter was perfect (4-4) from the field. This was a closely matched game in almost all areas.

What we learned from this game: Another hard-fought loss for Weber, which needs to win these types of close games to move up in the standings and make the 5A state tournament. Sometimes, the littlest things make the biggest difference.

Jan. 25 – Weber 52, Northridge 26

Story of the game: Erin Reichle scored 22 points and pulled down a season-high 12 rebounds as Weber had no trouble handling Northridge in a Region 1 game.

Weber’s highlights: The Warriors took control early and were able to empty the bench. The score was 23-8 by halftime and 38-11 after three quarters. Hannah Charlton chipped in eight points and McKenna Dahl had a nice game with five. Weber didn’t shoot particularly well, but forced a season-best 34 turnovers.

Northridge’s highlights: The Knights had trouble scoring due to too many turnovers and because leading scorer Sydnee Acord took 20 shots to score 14 points. As a team, the Knights were 8-49 (16.3 percent) from the field. Brittley Eldredge had 10 rebounds as the Knights won the battle for the boards.

Statistical notes: The 26 points allowed was a season best for Weber. Reichle had three treys but, surprisingly, only shot one free throw. Reichle was also credited with seven steals.

What we learned from this game: This was another must-win game. After dropping to many close ones to Region 1 contenders, the Warriors got a break on this night and buried the Knights. There was a lot less stress and most everyone got to play.
