

Feb. 8 – Syracuse 60, Weber 47

Story of the game: Erin Reichle had 26 points, but Weber blew a nine-point lead in the fourth quarter and saw its postseason hopes die with a Region 1 loss to Syracuse.

Weber’s highlights: Playing on its home floor, Weber had all the momentum with a 41-32 lead with just eight minutes left. However, nobody could score outside of Reichle. The Warriors had trouble shooting (26 percent) all night and again were humbled in the rebounding battle. The game got out of hand in the final minutes.

Syracuse’s highlights: The fourth-quarter surge was one of the best all season for the Titans. Takenna Hamblin, Logan Harker and Jayda Bovero each scored in double figures and Hamblin’s 14 rebounds were huge underneath as Syracuse held a 42-27 advantage there. The victory kept Syracuse’s hopes alive for a No. 2 seed.

Statistical notes: Weber was outscored 28-6 in the final period. Hannah Charlton and Maren Ulrich each were 1-10 from the field. Reichle was 5-6 from three-point range for the game, but couldn’t get a shot off late. Abbie O’Neill had just two points, but five made five steals.

What we learned from this game: The Warriors were so close. This was an emotional game on their “Senior Night,” but the loss eliminated them from the 5A state tournament.

Feb. 12 – Weber 56, Northridge 46

Story of the game: Erin Reichle, Maren Ulrich and Hanna Buswell each ended their basketball careers on a high note, playing key roles as Weber beat Northridge in the Region 1 season finale for both teams.

Weber’s highlights: The Warriors led the entire game and built an 18-point lead going into the final quarter. Coach Rick Stoeckl emptied the bench after that and the ending was bittersweet. Reichle had 19 points, Ulrich 12 and Buswell pulled down 13 rebounds to help Weber end its season on a high note.

Northridge’s highlights: This was the Knight’s “Senior Night” and, despite the loss, it ended well. Northridge made a nice rally in the final quarter. Sydnee Acord had 11 points, Tawnie Fitzgerald nine (three treys) and Kylee Christensen eight. Brittley Eldredge grabbed 13 rebounds and Northridge curtailed its turnover problems that happened last time.

Statistical notes: Northridge finished winless in Region 1. Acord was 0-9 from three-point range for the Knights. Buswell was Weber’s player of the game. She and Reichle combined for half of the team’s steals. Reichle, Ulrich and Buswell combined to shoot 5-10 on three-pointers.

What we learned from this game: Weber came in and played well, even though the Warriors had nothing to play for except pride. They started the game well and finished the year the best they could. Reichle also had scoring help.
